

# Shake and Spill: What Makes 10

**Materials:** plastic container

10 small objects (dried beans, lego pieces, shells)

Paper and pencil

**How to Play:** Put 10 little things in a container. Shake your container. Spill out a few on the table and write that number. Guess how many are still in the container... write out that number.

What strategy did you use to find your answer? Did you count on... think of your doubles?

Write a number sentence for your shake and spill.
